History of the Lady Icers

The Lady Icers hockey team was created when two Penn State students approached the rink supervisor in 1996 and inquired why there was no women's team at the University. After discovering that there was a lot of interest around campus, a team was quickly formed and practices began on Oct. 31, 1996. The team's first game was on Feb. 1, 1997. The Lady Icers won their inaugural game by defeating the Harrisburg Rocketts, 5-4. As a reflection of the growth of women's ice hockey, during the first season, the Lady Icers faced six opponents.

Since then, the team has expanded their schedule to a minimum of thirty games. The team is now an official Penn State Club team. The team has access to University facilities and programs. From a team where more than half the members had no ice hockey or competitive experience, the Lady Icers now have players on the team with many years of experience, which has led to tryouts the past few years. In 1999, the inaugural season of the Mid-Atlantic Women's Collegiate Hockey Association (MAWCHA), the Lady Icers went undefeated and claimed the league championship.



In the 2001-2002 season, the team continued to make history as it once again earned a trip to the National Tournament, and brought home its first ever ACHA trophy as third best team in the nation. The Lady Icers also had the Player of the Year and Tournament MVP that season.

The 2002-2003 season brought yet another trip to the National Tournament and an eighth place finish. The team also competed in the inaugural year of the Delaware Valley Collegiate Hockey Conference and won the Women's Division Championship, going undefeated in league play.

The Lady Icers made the 2004 and 2007 National Tournaments as well. They also made the ECHWL (Eastern Collegiate Women's Hockey League) Tournament in 2005 and 2008.
